The Verve Super Investment Universe is a list of companies, funds and assets that have passed our ethical screening methodology. This means that at any point in time, Verve Super may be invested in some or all of these investments. The Universe will be updated at least six-monthly.

Verve Super does not invest directly in all of these companies, funds and assets. In some cases, the Fund's exposure is obtained indirectly through an investment in an Exchange Traded Fund (ETF). When deciding to invest in an ETF, our Investment Manager, Future Super Investment Services Pty Ltd (ABN 55 621 040 702; AFS Representative No. 001271441), which is a Corporate Authorised Representative of Future Promoter Holdings Pty Ltd (ABN 90 167 800 580; AFSL 482684), considers the values and exposure guidelines of the ETF to ensure that the product fits with the values of our Fund. On a day-to-day basis, we rely on the screening of the ETF's underlying investments as undertaken by the ETF issuer. We review the screens applied to the ETF on an annual basis to ensure they remain consistent with our ethical screening methodology, however we acknowledge that there are limitations to our control over any changes that the ETF issuers might apply to their process for screening the underlying holdings. The holdings in this document are as at 31 July 2023. The relevant ETF holdings were downloaded between 27 – 31 July 2023.

You should read the <u>Product Disclosure Statement</u>, <u>Additional Information Booklet</u>, <u>Insurance Guide</u>, <u>Target Market Determination</u> and <u>Financial Services Guide</u> before making a decision to invest, or continue to invest, in Verve Super.

Helpful Definitions

We appreciate that the land of superannuation, investing, and finance can be a bit of a complex world to get your head around. We have compiled a list of helpful definitions below, and inserted explainers throughout the document to help you understand how your money is invested when you have a Verve Super account.

Asset Types

Alternatives	Alternative assets typically refer to investments that fall outside of the traditional asset classes commonly accessed by most investors, such as stocks, bonds and cash. They're generally private investments that are obtained directly from their source or issuer and are not tradable on public exchanges like the ASX. Alternatives can come in the form of private equity, private credit/debt, venture capital, real estate, infrastructure, and tangible assets. At Verve, we look for opportunities to invest directly in alternatives that are focused on making a positive social or environmental impact. Alternatives can be either 'Growth' or 'Defensive'. We expect growth alternatives to typically have higher returns, but more variability and thus more risk. Defensive alternatives are typically lower risk but also provide lower returns.
Equities	Equities are portions of ownership in a publicly-listed company. Equity is bought and sold in the form of shares or stocks, which are issued by companies as a way to raise money. When we invest in 'equities' we acquire shares - which basically means we own a small portion of the company. Verve Super is invested both directly and indirectly in Australian equities and international equities. An indirect investment means an investment via an Exchange Traded Fund (ETF).
Fixed Income	Fixed income assets broadly refers to investments that pay investors fixed interest or dividend payments until their maturity date. At maturity, investors are repaid the principal amount they had invested. Government and corporate bonds are the most common types of fixed-income products. A well-diversified investment portfolio typically includes fixed-income investments because they receive a predictable series of interest payments, and are generally lower risk than other asset types. Verve Super is invested both directly and indirectly in fixed income assets. An indirect investment means an investment via an Exchange Traded Fund (ETF).



Additional Definitions

Diversification / Diversified	We often talk about a 'diversified portfolio' or that certain assets contribute to 'diversification'. This is a common investing approach which is applied to ensure that each portfolio is invested in a range of asset classes (equities, fixed income, alternatives). Diversification can also be measured in respect of other factors, including the location of investments (domestic and international), and the size of investments.
Exchange Traded Funds ('ETF')	An exchange traded fund, or 'ETF', is an investment that is typically listed on a stock exchange, and generally tracks to an index. When you invest in an ETF you gain indirect exposure to all of the companies, assets and funds that the ETF invests in, which is a simple way to increase the diversification of your own investment portfolio.
Underlying Holdings	When we refer to 'underlying holdings' in the context of ETFs, we're referring to the companies, assets and funds that the ETF is invested in.

The Gender Index

Verve Super is an ethically invested, community-minded superannuation product created and designed to support our community of women+, and allies to build their retirement savings while investing for a more equitable and sustainable future, while advocating against gender-based discrimination, and supporting efforts to close the retirement savings gap for all women+.

There are a number of superannuation funds who screen out investment in negative industries like tobacco, gambling and fossil fuels. Yet no ethically invested fund has ever thought to look at how companies treat women in a meaningful way.

<u>Research shows</u> that companies with better gender diversity and inclusion perform better. So why don't all superannuation funds take this into consideration? At Verve Super, we decided to!

Our proprietary **Verve Gender Equality Investment Index** uses data collected by the Workplace Gender Equality Agency (WGEA) to construct a screen based on how Australian listed companies perform on key gender equity metrics. These metrics include gender pay parity, the number of women in leadership, anti-sexual harassment policies, and commitment to inclusivity and flexible work practices.

The Index uses standardised data from Australian private sector companies with more than 100 employees, who submit an annual report to WGEA. Once we have identified the top performing companies, we select the top five in each industry for inclusion in the Index. But don't worry - these investments still have to pass our negative screens to gain a place in our portfolio!

While similar gender equality indexes have been established overseas, including by Bloomberg and Impact Shares in the US, no other financial institution in Australia uses a similar investment measure.

Verve developed the Index in order to direct investment towards the top-performing companies on gender equality within the ASX 200, and also to screen out the poor performers. The research has shown that these companies perform better, plus they are in line with our Verve values – so for us it was a no brainer!





Alternative Impact Investments

Alternatives are generally private investments that are obtained directly from their source or issuer and are not tradable on public exchanges like the ASX. At Verve, we seek out direct investments in alternative investments that are focused on making a positive environmental impact, like renewable energy and renewable energy funds, as well as investments with a positive social impact.



PLENTI*

Plenti offers green loans to consumers so that they can fund solar, home battery and clean energy installations. Plenti has a Provision Fund which can be used to pay back investors like Verve if individual borrowers can't repay loans. The Provision Fund has a 100% track record of protecting investors.



RESOLVE SOCIAL BENEFIT BOND*

The Resolve Social Benefit Bond provides investors with an opportunity to generate a competitive financial return while improving the lives of people experiencing mental ill-health in NSW. Verve and other investors fund the Resolve Program, a recovery-orientated community support program which combines a residential service for periodic crisis care integrated psychosocial, medical and mental health support; and a warm line for after-hours support from peers.



SYNERGIS FUND*

Through the Synergis Fund, Verve Super is investing in transforming disability housing in Australia to support Australians on the NDIS to live independently at home or in specialist disability accommodation. The Synergis Fund is also part of a coalition of sector leaders working together to develop a common outcomes framework to understand the impact of housing and in-home support on the lives of people with disability.
